

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to apply for funds in the amount of \$389,651.00 for a Native Apache Teacher-Training Program on the Reservation under Indian Education (3) Part C., Educational Services for Indian Adults, 20 U.S.C. 1211a (b)., to improve educational opportunities for Indian adults by providing educational services that are not available in sufficient quantity and quality, and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs Elementary Schools of Cedar Creek and Cibecue have agreed to implement this program.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman is authorized and directed to submit a proposal to enter into a contract with the Department of Health, Education and Welfare, Office of Indian Education according to the guidelines under Part B., Title IV of the Indian Education Act as published in the application under Indian Education Program, November 1980, for the purposes hereinabove described.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized and directed to sign any and all documents required to consummate this contractual agreement.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1980, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
