## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been informed about the critical sewer and sanitation problems of Lucivia Colelay and Buddy Boni, at their residences in Whiteriver and Canyon Day, respectively; and
- WHEREAS, the information presented to the Tribal Council establishes that the sewer problems at these two residences create an immediate emergency health and sanitation problem as well as inconvenience to the Tribal member homes; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that it is necessary to immediately resolve the specific problems of these tribal members.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
  Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal White Mountain
  Apache Utility Authority to take all such actions as is
  necessary and propose to cure the sewer and sanitation
  problems at the residences of Mrs. Lucivia Colelay in
  Whiteriver and Mr. Buddy Boni in Canyon Day, respectively.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1980, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
