RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been requested by Mrs. Christian Fall, a tribal member, to review and consider her complaint regarding a housing dispute, and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Fall has informed the Council that she is fully up-to-date on her house payments to the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority, but that she is none-the-less being evicted, and
- WHEREAS, she has further informed the Council that the house is occupied by her adult children, with her consent, who are in bad need of proper housing, and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Fall has requested the Tribal Council's assistance in obtaining the consideration of the Housing Authority to stop the eviction order, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has thoroughly reviewed her request.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority to reconsider the position of Mrs. Christina Fall, a tribal member, and to thereupon cease the eviction process against her.

The foregoing resolution was on December 04, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
