RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has previously conducted interviews for applicants to the position of Tribal Attorney, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has selected Mr. Robert C. Brauchli for employment in such position subject to confirmation of a written contract with the Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, a proposed written contract between said attorney and the tribe has been presented to the Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, this Attorney Contract provides for a \$40,000.00 per annum salary, a one-year term subject to a six-months probationary period, expenses and other related contractual matters, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that the terms and conditions of this contract are satisfactory to the Tribal Council.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the written contract between Mr. Robert C. Brauchli and the Tribe, a copy of which is attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized and directed to execute said Attorney Contract for and on behalf of the Tribe, effective December 01, 1980.
- The foregoing resolution was on December 04, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested i- it by Article V, Section 1 (d) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
