


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to apply for grant funds in the amount of \$256,000.00 for the construction of a vocational education building to compliment the skill center, under the U. S. Department of Education, Office of Vocational and Adult Education, CFDA Number 84.101.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman is authorized and directed to submit a proposal to enter into a contract with the U. S. Department of Education, Office of Vocational and Adult Education, according to the guidelines as published under the application for grants under the program for Indian tribes and Indian organizations, November 1980, for the purposes herein-above described.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized and directed to sign any and all documents required to consummate this contractual agreement.


The foregoing resolution was on December 04, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
