RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribe has encouraged individual members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to enter into business, and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Odette (Cooley) Fuller desires to purchase the store in Cibecue known as Apache Traders from Mrs. Barbara Cooley, and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Barbara Cooley has agreed to sell Apache Traders to Mrs. Odette Full and relinquish her existing lease.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Mrs. Odette (Cooley) Fuller be granted a twenty-five (25) year lease for a business in the Cibecue community.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council authorizes and directs the Chairman of the Tribal Council to approve a business lease to Mrs. Odette Fuller that will reflect all of the special stipulations that are normally in all tribal member business leases operating on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on January 07, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
