## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe passed Resolution No. 80-259 requesting the University of Arizona to remove the Extension Agent, Calvin Emerson, from his position under the Agricultural Extension Program on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and to replace him with a capable and responsive individual to fulfill the purposes of the program as soon as possible, and
- WHEREAS, the intent of Resolution No. 80-259 was misconstrued, and all the employees of the Agricultural Extension Program on the reservation were terminated.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests the University of Arizona to appoint a new Agricultural Extension Agent other than Calvin Emerson.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the position of Extension Agent be filled as originally requested in Resolution No. 80-259.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs Superintendent is hereby requested to assist the Tribe in fulfilling the purposes of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on January 08, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
