RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been made aware of approximately \$161,722.00 in Title XX funding that may be applied for from the Arizona Department of Economic Security, Title XX Administration, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has prioritized nutritional supplementation and information and referral services as Tribal objectives.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman is directed to apply for Title XX funds for nutritional supplementation and information and referral services for the Apache people, or to address any other Tribal priorities qualifying under the Title XX program.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman is authorized and directed to take all actions required to complete an agreement with the Title XX Administration for funding under the Title XX Program.

The foregoing resolution was on January 08, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
