

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe owns and operates the White Mountain Apache Development Enterprise, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Development Enterprise is in need of a permanent Construction Superintendent/Enterprise Manager rather than a temporary or Acting Superintendent, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that it is in the best interests of the Tribe to re-advertise that position as soon as possible, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further finds that it is in the best interests of the Tribe to delete the special requirement that was previously included in the Job Announcement that the applicants for said position must have access to large quantities of liquid or tangible assets for equipment rental to the Enterprise, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council believes it is in the best interests of the Tribe to prefer that an applicant be a graduate from an accredited College or University with a degree in engineering but not to require the degree.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Personnel Office to re-advertise the position of the General Manager of the White Mountain Apache Development Enterprise immediately in conformity with this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Personnel Office of the White Mountain Apache Tribe submit names of qualified applicants to the Tribal Council for final selection.

The foregoing resolution was on January 08, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
