RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised and informed that Resolution No. 80-319 was not submitted to the Bureau of Indian Affairs within ten days from the meeting, and

WHEREAS, the Council is further informed that Resolution No. 80-319 needs to be amended to cover fifty-six (56) applicants, not fifty-three (53) as was recommended.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reaffirms and amends Resolution No. 80-319 for the adoption of fifty-six (56) applicants into the membership of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on January 08, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article III, Section 2 of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
