

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been requested by the majority of the employees of the Apache Development Enterprise that Mr. Neal Hall be permanently appointed to the position as General Manager of said Enterprise; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised by said employees that a Manager other than Mr. Neal Hall would require at least six months orientation before he is familiar with the people and the requirements of the position; and
- WHEREAS, the employees of Apache Development Enterprise have expressed their feelings that Mr. Neal Hall is most qualified and familiar with the needs and requirements of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and has demonstrated integrity and loyalty to the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that the wishes of the majority of the employees is important as well as the financial stability of Apache Development Enterprise; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that Neal Hall enjoys the confidence of not only the employees of the Apache Development Enterprise but also the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development;
- BE IT RESOLVED that Mr. Neal Hall is hereby permanently appointed to the management of Apache Development Enterprise;
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Personnel Department of the White Mountain Apache Tribe be directed to notify Neal Hall of his permanent appointment pursuant to the terms and provisions of the agreement presently existing between the Tribe and Mr. Neal Hall

The foregoing resolution was on February 4, 1981, duly adopted by a vote of six for and five against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it

by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and  
By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and  
approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958,  
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
