WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been requested by Mr. Jed Day for renewal of his Geological Study Permit in order that he might be permitted to continue his geological studies on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and


WHEREAS the Tribal Council has previously granted to Mr. Jed Day a Geological Studies Permit; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is satisfied with the need for a renewal of said Geological Studies Permit for the purposes of described by Jed Day;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Geological Study Permit granted to Jed Day be hereby renewed until July 31, 1981, at which time it will terminate.

The foregoing resolution was on February 4, 1981, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
