RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the United States of America, acting through the Indian Health Service, Department of Health, and Human Services, has installed domestic water-supply and sewage disposal facilities for houses scattered throughout the communities of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation (Projects PH 76-290); and
- WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service has requested an agreement by and between the Indian Health Service, and the White Mountain Apache Tribe, the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority, and the White Mountain Apache Utility Authority to affect transfer of facilities; and
- WHEREAS, this Transfer Agreement has been considered by the Tribal Council and approved in terms and conditions.
- BF. IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe
 is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement for the
 transfer of domestic water-supply and sewage disposal
 facilities for houses scattered throughout the communities
 of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 4, 1981</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine for</u> and <u>zero against</u> by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
