RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been requested by Freda Newhall a tribal member, that she be permitted to purchase a Mutual-Help home; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that Freda Newhall has resided in a Low-Rent Housing for six to seven years in Whiteriver; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further advised that she has made numerous good faith applications to be selected for participation in the Mutual-Help Housing Program; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds Freda Newhall's financial situation complies with the local requirements and does not differ in any appreciable way from other successful applications.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby recommends to the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority Commissioners that Freda Newhall be permitted to purchase at the Mutual-Hlpe Housing Program within the earliest possible time.

The foregoing resolution was on February 4, 1981, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
