

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has for many years constructed, repaired and maintained irrigation ditches and canals for the benefit of tribal members, and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs annual budgeting process for irrigation construction monies requires that Fiscal Year 1983 requirements be submitted at this time, supported by a Tribal Resolution of approval, and

WHEREAS, the following project (BIA No. 069), consisting of two (2) operations for a total of \$100,000.00 submitted for council action, as follows:

1. Completion of Canyon Day pipeline - \$60,000.00; addition of 6,700 feet of ditch lining to an existing 5,400-foot pipeline completed in Fiscal Year 1980, and
2. Planning and Investigation - \$40,000.00; for planning the reorganization of the complete supply and delivery system for the irrigated lands along the East Fork of the White River; said plan resulting in a more dependable and efficient water delivery system to the East Fork area; the said improvements being fully described in documents D-32 and D-33--attached and made a part hereof by reference, and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 1983 operation and maintenance budget of \$60,000.00 is attached (documents D-69 and D-70) and made a part hereof by reference; the operation and maintenance budget funds being essential to the continued operation of individual irrigation activities on the Reservation through 1983, and


WHEREAS, the above facilities improvements and operational funding will assist the Tribal members to more fully and effectively use their land and water resources in the future to improve their living conditions.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council hereby approves the above-listed Bureau of Indian Affairs Budget requests and urges that they be included in the Federal Budget for Fiscal Year 1983.

The foregoing resolution was on February 5, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
