WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is concerned with the safety of its roads on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and


WHEREAS, the Council were advised that there have been several accidents on Highway 73 near the Baptist Church, North Whiteriver, Arizona, and


WHEREAS, the Arizona Highway Department is responsible for the maintenance and safety of said Highway 73.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests the Arizona Highway Department to evaluate the safety of Highway 73, in the area of the Baptist Church, and make the necessary corrections to make the road safe to travel.

The foregoing resolution was on February 17, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
