## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council, by Resolution No. 79-240 of December 11, 1979, created the White Mountain Apache Agricultural Enterprise, merging into the Enterprise the Agriculture Extension Program (A.E.P.) that had been operated in the past as a service for individual gardens and small-acreage farms, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Agricultural Enterprise is created to operate as a large-scale agricultural business requiring larger field equipment than the A.E.P. and full-time use of both labor and equipment, and is therefore incompatible with the basic requirements of the Agricultural Extension Program.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
  Tribe that it hereby approves the separation of the
  Agriculture Extension Program from the White Mountain
  Apache Agricultural Enterprise, restoring the A.E.P. to
  its original status as a community service program funded
  by a combination of fee payments and tribal funds.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Tribal Council Resolution No. 79-240 (Paragraph 7) be amended to read:

"BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the creation of the White Mountain Apache Agricultural Enterprise" - deleting therefrom the clause" . . . the merger of its current irrigation project operations with the Agriculture Extension Program for...".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the budgets of the respective entities be revised to reflect the separation herein directed; said budget revisions to be submitted expeditiously to the Finance Committee for inclusion in the Tribal Fiscal Year 1981-82 Budget.

The foregoing resolution was on March 04, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
