

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been presented with a recommendation from the Land Board minutes of its meeting of February 23, 1981, and

WHEREAS, the Land Board had approved a A Pistol Range covering six (6) acres of land in the Canyon Day area for the White Mountain Apache Tribal Police Department.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the Pistol Range application covering six (6) acres of land in the Canyon Day area for the White Mountain Apache Tribal Police Department.

The foregoing resolution was on March 16, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
