

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised by the White Mountain Apache Agricultural Enterprise of the great necessity for it to purchase farm equipment in the amount of \$180,000.00 so that the Canyon Day irrigated land can be farmed in the spring, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the farming cannot be done without the proposed purchase of equipment and that the present equipment is not suitable or adequate for the amount of acreage to be farmed in the spring of 1981, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been provided a list of equipment by the White Mountain Apache Agricultural Enterprise which it needs in order to farm the Canyon Day irrigated acreage and it being satisfied that the development and farming of said acreage is in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and will constitute significantly toward its goal of economic self-sufficiency.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the White Mountain Apache Agricultural Enterprise meet with the Budget Committee within ten (10) days for the purpose of locating funds for the immediate purchase of the necessary farm equipment and to make the necessary financial arrangements for the lease and/or purchase of said equipment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that upon completion of the necessary financial arrangements for the lease and/or purchase of the farm equipment to the Budget Committee's satisfaction, that the White Mountain Apache Agricultural Enterprise immediately lease and/or purchase said equipment and report progress toward their acquisition to the Tribal Council at the April Regular Council Meeting.


