RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mr. Roland Ethelbah, an applicant, appeared before the Tribal Council requesting enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Ethelbah has filed all the required enrollment documents with the Tribe, including a relinquishment of membership from the Navajo Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Iribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Roland Ethelbah, DOB: December 02, 1961, Indian Blood Degree: 1/2 White Mountain Apache Indian Tribe and 1/2 Navajo Indian Tribe, be officially adopted into the membership of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to Article III, Section 2 of the Amended Constitution of the Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on April 01, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article III, Section 2 of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
