RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has had brought to its attention that Judith A. Miketta Acting Editor of the Fort Apache Scout, has been working in that capacity satisfactorily for at least six (6) months, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is of the opinion that it would be in the best interest of the Fort Apache Scout, which is a valuable communications media for the people of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, that a permanent Editor be appointed to the Fort Apache Scout, and
 - WHEREAS, Judith A. Miketta has proven herself to be a capable Editor for the Fort Apache Scout.
 - BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Judith A. Miketta is hereby appointed as permanent Editor for the Fort Apache Scout at the present salary with all fringe benefits.
 - BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this appointment shall be deemed effective as of April 07, 1981 and shall continue until further action by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on April 07, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
