

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise has the need for additional revenues to run the Enterprise, and

WHEREAS, the Old Big Cienega Ski run is no longer being used for skiing purposes, and

WHEREAS, the Sunrise Hotel area offers great possibilities for a recreational area.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Recreation Enterprise be permitted to use the Old Big Cienega Ski run for sledding and tubing by permit.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sunrise Hotel area bordered by Highway #260 on the North, Highway #273 on the West and South and the reservation boundary fence on the East be opened to crosscountry skiing and snowmobiling by permit under the authority and auspices of the Recreation Enterprise.

The foregoing resolution was on April 20, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
