

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise has the need for more revenues to run the Enterprise, and

WHEREAS, the strong winds on Sunrise Lake create a problem for fishermen in boats with only electric motors, and

WHEREAS, allowing fishermen to use small gasoline (maximum 7.5 horsepower) engines would increase use on Sunrise Lake and not harm the lake.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby allows the use of gasoline engines of 7.5 horsepower or less on Sunrise Lake only, commencing April 20, 1981.

The foregoing resolution was on April 20, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
