

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise operating expenses have increased during 1980, and

WHEREAS, additional revenues are needed in 1981 to keep the Enterprise operating with a profit.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Recreation Enterprise is hereby authorized to increase daily fishing and camping fees as follows:

\$3.50 per day per adult fishermen
\$3.50 per day per family for camping

The foregoing resolution was on April 20, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
