## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service Sanitation Facilities Construction Branch Program, under P.L. 86-121 is currently subject to a hiring freeze, and
- WHEREAS, all of the temporary clerical, technical and force account employees working within the Sanitation Facilities Construction Branch will complete their one-year assignments in September 1981, and
- WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service can transfer funds to the Tribe by means of a Memorandum of Agreement for payment of wages for employees hired by the Tribe to complete sanitation facilities construction.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain
  Apache Tribe that it approves and recommends that the
  Tribe enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the
  Indian Health Service whereby the Tribe hires employees
  to complete any necessary clerical, technical and/or
  administrative work necessary to complete currently
  funded sanitation construction projects and that the
  Indian Health Service transfer funds to the Tribe
  from construction funds for this purpose.

The foregoing resolution was on May 13, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
