

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe annually establishes a "day-light savings" business-hours schedule for the summer months of each year, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council considers such action in the perspective of the interests of the tribal employees as well as of proper tribal business operations.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby establishes business hours as follows:

7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. - Business hours

12:00 noon to 1:00 p.m. - Lunch break

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above schedule is for all departments and branches of the Central Tribe, and for such tribal enterprises as may choose to also use such schedule.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this directive is effective beginning at 7:30 a.m. on May 18, 1981, and ending on September 5, 1981, Labor Day Weekend.


