RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe reviewed the Apache Youth budget from the White Mountain Apache Tribal Land Claims Funds specifically from the administrative fund, and
- WHEREAS, the 1981 proposed budget for the said program was prepared to implement a summer program to utilize the remaining administrative funds, and
- WHEREAS, the amount of \$39,377.00 represents all that remains of the monies earmarked for administrative funds, and
- WHEREAS, said Apache Youth Program shall terminate upon the exhaustion of said \$39,377.00.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the budget for the Apache Youth Program is approved in the amount of \$39,377.00 which represents the remaining balance from the administrative fund.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the funds for said program be appropriated from the Land Claims Funds on deposit with the United States Government designated as administrative funds in order to fund the Apache Youth Program.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Apache Youth Program terminate upon exhaustion of this summer's administrative funding of \$39,377.00.

The foregoing resolution was on May 14, 1981, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) & (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
