RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the distribution of land claims monies under Docket 22-D provided funds for the communities on the reservation for Recreation projects, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council discussed the funds programmed specifically for the communities which are not being utilized to the fullest extent for which it was intended.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the balance of \$207,838.40 for community projects be programmed immediately.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that each Council Member is responsible for immediately meeting with members of the community which he represents for the purpose of programming and planning expenditures of the percentage of monies assigned to the community from the land claims fund of Docket 22-D.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that each Council Member prepare a report regarding their community's planned expenditures of 22-D monies and file said report with the Chairman within sixty (60) days hereof.

The foregoing resolution was on May 14, 1981, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) & (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
