RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Miss Denise Joe, a tribal member, has requested that the Tribal Council appropriate \$150.00 to her so that she may participate in the Miss United Teenager Pageant, and
- WHEREAS, Miss Denise Joe has requested that the White Mountain Apache Tribe sponsor her for participation in the pageant, and
- WHEREAS, the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has advised the Tribal Council that there are monies availabile in the Public Relations Account, but the Tribal Council approval is necessary in order to release said funds to Miss Denise Joe, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is pleased to support Miss Denise Joe's participation in the Miss United Teenager Pageant, and further is unanimous in its approval and encouragement for her success in the pageant.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Miss Denise Joe's request for \$150.00 and sponsored by the Tribe in order that she might participate in the Miss United Teenager Pageant is hereby granted.

The foregoing resolution was on May 14, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
