


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Lorinda Dude an enrolled tribal member has requested that the Tribal Council direct that her name be placed on the list to receive and be eligible for Mutual-Help Housing; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that Lorinda Dude had previously declined Mutual-Help housing but that said declination was made at a time when she was suffering from the shock and trauma of the sudden tragic death of her husband at the Fort Apache Timber Company timber mill; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further advised that Lorinda Dude rescinded her declination very soon after she declined the Mutual-Help housing; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that there is a good cause to reinstate Lorinda Dude's name to the list of eligible participants and to receive Mutual-Help house at the site of her choice approved by the Local Housing Authority.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Housing Authority is hereby directed to place Lorinda Dude's name on the list of eligible persons to receive Mutual-Help housing.

The foregoing resolution was on June 2, 1981, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
