FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe was informed by Mrs. Hawthorne Harrina that the MIRACLE CHURCH desires to hold a two-week Church Camp Meeting beginning in July, 1981; and

WHEREAS, the Camp Meeting will be sponsored by Mr. Hawthorne Harrina and it will be held in the corn field of Mrs. Dora Kessay, a tribal member of Whiteriver, Arizona; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe accepts the request and gives its approval.

BE IT RESOVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the request of tribal members of the MIRACLE CHURCH to sponsor a two-week Camp Meeting beginning July 24, 1981, through August 18, 1981.

The foregoing resolution was on June 2, 1981, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
