RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that the late Mr. Ernest Newhall, Sr., and Edith Wool lived as and were acknowledged as husband and wife; and
- WHEREAS, the late Ernest Newhall, Sr., was assigned HIP housing prior to his death and was to occupy HIP housing with Edith Wool as husband and wife when said housing was available; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been requested by Edith Wool to be assigned the HIP housing in the name of Mr. Ernest Newhall, Sr. widow of Ernest Newhall; and
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Edith Wool a/k/a Mrs. Ernest Newhall, Sr., be assigned HIP housing which was formerly assigned to Mr. Ernest Newhall, Sr.

The foregoing resolution was on July 1, 1981, duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
