RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, on the 16th of January, 1963, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council adopted Ordinance No. 47, establishing a Housing Authority on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in its endeavor to alleviate the sub-standard housing for its low-income families, and
- WHEREAS, Resolution No. 78-153 appointed Mr. Raymus Albert to serve as Commissioner of the Housing Authority, and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Raymus Albert's term as Commissioner expires on July 13, 1981, and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Albert has exemplified his service as a Commissioner in an outstanding manner and is an asset to the Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Mr. Raymus Albert is hereby reappointed for a term of four (4) years as a member of the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority, commencing July 13, 1981 and terminating July 13, 1985.

The foregoing resolution was on July 2, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to it authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i & s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
