RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised that there is a need according to Arizona State Law to appoint a new agent for the Tribal Liquor License due to the untimely and unfortunate passing away of Sidney Ethelbah, and
- WHEREAS, Wesley Bonito, has been nominated and approved to be the successor Agent for the State Liquor License by the Board of Directors of the White Mountain Apache Enterprise and the Fort Apache Development Corporation, Inc. in whose name the license is held, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council approves the nomination of Wesley Bonito to be the successor agent for the Tribal Liquor License.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Wesley Bonito is hereby appointed as the successor agent for the liquor license, held in the name of the Fort Apache Development Corporation, Inc.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Wesley Bonito is directed by the Tribal Council to complete all necessary applications to the State of Arizona in order to maintain the various liquor license throughout the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on July 2, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i & s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
