RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been requested by KVSL for permission to place a radio tower on Pinetop Mountain inside the boundaries of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation for purposes of enhancing and improving radio reception on the reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council hereby acknowledges that KVSL has in the past assisted the White Mountain Apache Tribe through the Apache Hour and other Apache oriented programs, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council believes it would be in the interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to enhance KVSL Radio reception within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, it appears that a lease agreement will be required to be entered into between the White Mountain Apache Tribe and KVSL for the leasing of a tower site on Pinetop Mountain.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it approves a proposal by KVSL to lease a tower site on Pinetop Mountain.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that approval for negotiations of said tower site lease be subject to and conditioned upon Tribal Council approval of a lease agreement between the White Mountain Apache Tribe and KVSL.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Attorney is directed to coordinate negotiations with the Bureau of Indian Affairs Realty Office and KVSL reference the lease for the tower site on Pinetop Mountain.

The foregoing resolution was on September 9, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authrity vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
