RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised by West Anderson, Tribal Council Member, that there is serious erosion in Bear Canyon Wash near the Canyon Day rodeo grounds area; and

WHEREAS, he also advised that streambank protection is necessary near the Canyon Day pump station area to protect the pumps from flooding; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Anderson requests that the Tribal Roads and Construction Enterprise be directed to correct the erosion at Bear Canyon Wash near the Canyon Day rodeo grounds area and to initiate streambank protection at the Canyon Day pump station, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds good cause for the same.

BE IT RESOVLED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Roads and Construction Enterprise is hereby directed to remedy the erosion problem at Bear Canyon Wash near the Canyon Day rodeo grounds and to construct streambank protection for the pump area at Canyon Day.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1981, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f and h) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
