RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Recreation Enterprise has requested permission from the Tribal Council to approve the sale of varmint calling permit to non-tribal members for the price of \$250.00 each at designated areas at designated season dates subject to certain firearm restrictions; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council having debated and discussed the wisdom of approving such sales to non-tribal members and concluding that good cause exist to deny the request of the Recreation Enterprise.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that it hereby denies the request of the Recreation
 Enterprise for the sale of varmint calling permits to
 non-tribal members for the price of \$250.00 each for a
 season date of November 1, 1981 through February 28,
 1982.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1981, duly adopted by a vote of 5 for and 6 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
