

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Ramon Riley, Station Manager for the Apache Radio Broadcasting Corporation has advised the Tribal Council that the Radio Station Board of Directors has reviewed several Architectural firms for purposes of selecting one to design the building for the new Radio Station, and

WHEREAS, the Radio Station Board of Directors recommends that Richard M. Reif and Associates, a Tucson Architectural Firm is best qualified and experienced to meet the needs of the Apache Radio Broadcasting Corporation, and

WHEREAS, the Station Manager requests that the Tribal Council authorize the Chairman and Tribal Attorney to enter into pre-bid contract negotiations with Richard M. Reif and Associates, and the council approving said request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman and the Tribal Attorney are hereby directed to meet with the appropriate representatives of the Apache Radio Broadcasting Corporation and Richard M. Reif and Associates for purposes of negotiating a contract for architect services.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is hereby delegated the authority to enter into a contract with Richard M. Reif and Associates immediately if agreeable contract terms can be negotiated to his satisfaction.

The foregoing resolution was on December 03, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
