RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Edgar Perry has advised the Tribal Council that the rizona Department of Tourism has requested that he, Head of the Culture Center and the Tribal Chairman, Ronnie Lupe jpin with the representatives of three other Arizona Indian Tribes for a meeting to be held in Frankfurt, Germany for purposes of creating and promoting German tourism on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, Hopi, Navajo and Camp Verde Indian Reservations, and
- WHEREAS, the Germany Department of Tourism has expressed great interest in promoting such a program, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe concludes that such a program would be beneficial to the economic wellbeing of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby supports the efforts of the Tribal Chairman, Ronnie Lupe and Edgar Perry, Director of the Apache Culture Center, to promote German Tourism on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council wishes the Chairman and Director of the Apache Culture Center a safe and prosperous trip to Frankfurt, Germany scheduled from December 05 through December 19, 1981.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council hereby expresses its gratitude to the Arizona Department of Tourism, TWA and German Department of Tourism for their generosity in paying for all of the airfare and expenses of our tribal representatives in order that they might be able to attend the meeting in Germany at no cost to the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on December 03, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
