

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has submitted a HUD Community Development Block Grant Preapplication for a Community Services Building and a Sanitary landfill, and


WHEREAS, a response letter from HUD requests that the Tribe prioritize some elements within the landfill proposal, and

WHEREAS, such prioritization may be necessary if the items continue to be considered as separate activities.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the following order of activities expresses the Tribe's priorities for these items, should they need to be separated from the Sanitary Landfill Activities:

1. Sanitary Landfill
2. Access Roads
3. Recycling Equipment
4. Resale Center Building

The foregoing resolution was on December 3, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
