

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe reviewed the Fiscal Year 1983 program priorities previously established by the Tribal Council, as requested by the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe confirms that the priorities previously established are still valid.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Council protests the manner in which questions concerning the effect of Fiscal Year 1983 Budget cuts on the Fiscal Year 1983 base amounts were unanswered, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe requests that cuts not be made to the Fiscal Year 1983 Budget.

The foregoing resolution was on December 7, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for 3 abstentions and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i & k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
