RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is the Governing Body, of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to Contract for the Fiscal Year 1983 and each year thereafter for the Higher Education Grant of the Bureau of the Indian Affairs, and
- WHEREAS, the P.L. 93-638 Community Education and Johnson O'Malley Program has, in the past, been handled successfully, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council authorized the Tribal Education Director to develop, plan, negotiate and execute the contract and/or any amendments, and
- WHEREAS, the authority granted under this resolution to the Tribal Education Director is to run concurrent with the term of the contract October 1, 1982 to September 30, 1983 and each succeeding year thereafter.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman is authorized and directed to sign the negotiated Higher Education Grant Program contract for Fiscal Year 1983.

The foregoing resolution was on January 6, 1982, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b,k,t) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe, June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
