## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal member, Beverly Ann Quay, has advised the Tribal Council that she is in constant state of fright of death as a result of being continually threatened and assaulted by her ex-boy friend, one Ronald Dean Sackett, who is not a tribal member and is known to be violent, and
- WHEREAS, Beverly Ann Quay further advises the Council that Ronald Dean Sackett is now in jail for the assault and battery committed upon her, but is now released having completed the jail sentence and is now living with friends on the Reservation, but that she remains in constant fear in dread of retaliation and reprisal against her, and
- WHEREAS, Tribal Council concludes that such undesirable conduct committed by and threatened by, Ronald Dean Sackett, threatens the health, safety, and welfare of Beverly Ann Quay and other tribal members within the exterior boundaries of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, Tribal Council concludes that the Tribal Attorney should be directed to advise Beverly Ann Quay as to remedies available to her in the Tribal Court and, if necessary, obtain those remedies for her through the Tribal Court to ensure that Ronald Dean Sackett is permanently enjoined from threatening, contacting, speaking with, or harrassing in any way whatsoever, Beverly Ann Quay or her child.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Attorney is hereby directed to advise Beverly Ann Quay and, if necessary, obtain for her, relief through the authority of the Tribal Court in the form of a Court Order prohibiting Ronald Dean Sackett from contacting, speaking with, harrassing, approaching, or intimidating in any way, Beverly Ann Quay or her immediate family.

The foregoing resolution was on February 03, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (q, t, and u) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
