## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1 (q) of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution and By-Laws, has the inherent sovereign power to provide for the removal or exclusion of any non-members of the Tribe whose presence may be injurious to the people on the reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that there is a great need for a Tribal Ordinance which would provide for the expulsion and exclusion from the reservation of non-members of the tribe whose presence may be injurious to the people on the reservation which provides due process and otherwise comports with the provisions of the Indian Civil Rights Act of 1968.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Attorney to draft an Ordinance providing for the expulsion, eviction and exclusion from the reservation of non-members whose presence and conduct or character threatens to injure or injurious to the people of the reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on February 05, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (q) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
