RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mrs. Dorothy Antonio and Mrs. Gertie Lupe, sisters, have requested from the Tribal Council a business lease for the building located south of the Whiteriver Garage which formerly was utilized as a laundry, but is now being used as a storage building for the White Mountain Apache Commercial Shopping Center, and
- WHEREAS, Dorothy Antonio and Gertie Lupe have advised the Tribal Council that they wish to open up a small grocery and convenience market and need a Tribal-Member Business Lease, the period of time of which to be negotiated separately at a future date with the Tribal Attorney and/or the Tribal Chairman, and
- WHEREAS, Gertie Lupe further advises the Tribal Council that the Commercial Shopping Center management is willing to remove merchandise and stored items from the building so that it can be converted to use as a grocery market and convenience store.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the execution of a business lease between the White Mountain Apache Tribe and tribal members Dorothy Antonio and Gertie Lupe for the purposes of operating a grocery and convenience market.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it directs a copy of this resolution be delivered to the General Manager of the Commercial Shopping Center with the suggestion that he meet with tribal members Dorothy Antonio and Gertie Lupe to arrange a time and place for the removal of the stored items from the building so that the building can be converted for the purposes outlined by Dorothy Antonio and Gertie Lupe.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that Dorothy Antonio and Gertie Lupe are instructed to meet with either the Tribal Attorney or the Office of the Chairman for purposes of drafting a business lease as to the duration of the lease and other provisions within thirty (30) days of the date of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on May 12, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
