

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe realizes that the best interests of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, there is a need to establish two (2) additional Tribal Positions, specifically, the positions of a Director to oversee the Tribal Boundary Patrol Department and the position of a Sales-Manager Coordinator for the White Mountain Apache Tribal Agricultural Enterprise, and
- WHEREAS, the proposed positions are necessary to improve upon a lack of supervision and are further necessary because of the growth of the utilization of tribal natural resources and progress being made in certain tribal enterprises to utilize those resources, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that there should be permanent positions created for Director of the Tribal Boundary Patrol Department and for Sales-Manager Coordinator of the Agricultural Enterprise, and
- WHEREAS, the proposed positions must be established and budgeted for by the Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council believes that Lafe Altaha is best suited to fill the position of Director of the Tribal Boundary Patrol Department and West Anderson, Sr. is well suited to fill the position of Sales-Manager Coordinator for the White Mountain Apache Tribal Agricultural Enterprise, and
- WHEREAS, the salaries and benefits for these two positions are to be negotiated by the Tribal Council when budgets for these specific departments; namely, the Boundary Patrol Department and the Agricultural Enterprise, are presented to the Tribal Council for final approval.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby establishes as permanent positions, the position of Director of the Tribal Boundary Patrol Department and the position of Sales-Manager Coordinator for the White Mountain Apache Tribal Agricultural Enterprise.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above positions are to be filled as follows:

Lafe Altaha as Director to oversee the Tribal Boundary Patrol Department and West Anderson, Sr. to fill the position of Sales-Manager Coordinator for the White Mountain Apache Tribal Agricultural Enterprise, effective upon budget approval.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that salaries and benefits for these two positions are to be negotiated with the Tribal Council at a future date when the positions for the Boundary Patrol Department and the Agricultural Enterprise are presented to the Tribal Council for final approval of the 1982/1983 Fiscal Year.

The foregoing resolution was on May 19, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
