

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Ramon Riley, General Manager of the Apache Radio Station, reports to the Tribal Council that it is necessary that Nelson Curtis and Raymond Endfield, Jr. be retained on the Board of Directors for the Apache Radio Broadcasting Corporation until July 08, 1982 in order to legally comply with contract requirements which require resolutions from a complete Board of Directors, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Mr. Riley's request is welltaken.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that Nelson Curtis and Raymond Endfield, Jr. be retained on the Board of Directors for the Apache Radio Station until July 08, 1982.

The foregoing resolution was on June 03, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i & s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
