RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has requested that Bureau of Indian Affairs rebuild and repave Route 44 FATCO Road to the Industrial Park Intersection from Arizona State Highway 73 near the Shopping Center; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe wishes to grant a gratuitous Right-of-Way,60 feet in width, a distance of 0.859 mile and 100 feet in width, a distance of 0.127 mile for a total distance of 0.986 mile; and
- WHEREAS, this section of road and bridge was built by EDA Grant and no right-of-way was granted at that time to the Bureau of Indian Affairs.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that it grants to the Bureau of Indian Affairs a
 gratuitous Right-of-Way as recorded on a map on file in
 the Office of the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian
 Agency, Whiteriver, Arizona, to which reference is hereby
 made.

The foregoing resolution was on June 25, 1982, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
