

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has received complaints from Tribal members living in the upper East Fork and Seven Mile area about low water pressure which has caused water shortage in homes and further causes unsanitary conditions and great inconvenience, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that this water shortage problem could be solved with the installation of a larger pump at each well and by hooking up to the large water tank right behind the East Fork Community Building for the East Fork area and possibly drilling more wells, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Utility Authority is the proper tribal agency to investigate this problem and to prescribe corrective measures appropriate for the East Fork and Seven Mile area and to apply to Indian Health Services for possible financial assistance in order to resolve the water shortage.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs Paschal Johnson, director of the White Mountain Apache Utility Authority to correct the water shortage problem at upper East Fork and Seven Mile and to install the necessary pumps and make the necessary hookup to the water tank behind the East Fork Community Building and elsewhere as appropriate to correct the problem.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Utility Authority through Paschal Johnson apply to I.H.S. for technical and financial assistance in resolving the water problem if necessary.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Paschal Johnson provide councilman Alvino Hawkins, who shall act as the contact person for the Council on this matter, with a progress report on corrective action taken within thirty (30) days of his receipt of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on June 25, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) and (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
