RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is informed that the Arizona State Museum has made application for a permit under the Federal Antiquities Act, 16 U.S.C. 431-433, and

WIEREAS, the Arizona State Museum is a part of the University of Arizona, and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the permit application is to make archaeological investigations, including excavating, collecting and making intensive studies on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the essence of a permit under the Federal Antiquities Act, 16 U.S.C. 431-433, to the Arizona State Museum, University of Arizona, pursuant to their application for service to undertake archaeological investigations on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this is not a blanket approval, but is subject to the condition that the permit is approved on a project to project basis, and that the Arizona State Museum will notify the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Bureau of Indian Affairs when they will be on the Reservation working on a specific project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized and directed to execute any and all documents necessary to carry out all conditions of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on July 09, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 2 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
